Cllr. Clements has written a paper dealing with the highway/public transport aspects.

Of the 300 replies to the survey the main concerns were:-

- 1) Regeneration of the High Street.
- 2) Traffic – speed and quantity.
- 3) Crime and policing.
- 4) Facilities for the young and the environment.

An action plan must be put together.

It was agreed that three people should go through all the questionnaires. The old Village Plan will also be studied. Thought to be given as to how to analyse the data.

In the Plan there should be an article from our PCSO.

The Plan should contain photographs.

It was agreed to take up Richards offer to design the Plan. Design and copyright to be the Parish Councils.
